Directions

From Oldham

Follow the brown 'Saddleworth Tourist Attractions' signs (A669 to Holmfirth) which will take you into Uppermill (4 miles approx).UMC is situated on the right in the square, just after the second pedestrian crossing.

From Ashton-Under-Lyne

From the Ashton bypass (A635) follow the signs for Tameside General Hospital along the A670 which will take you into Uppermill (4 miles approx). UMC is situated on the right in the square, just after the second pedestrian crossing.

From Huddersfield

Take the (A62) from Huddersfield to Oldham through Marsden following signs for Uppermill. UMC is situated on the left in the square, just before the pedestrian crossing.

From the M62

Leave M62 at Junction 22 on A672 towards Manchester; at Junction Inn turn left and immediate right to Delph and Dobcross. Continue through Delph to the dogsleg junction. Go straight across to Dobcross. Follow the road to a mini roundabout. Take the second exit towards Uppermill. Pass the garden centre on the right. Turn right at the next roundabout, go under the viaduct. UMC is situated on the left in the square, just before the pedestrian crossing.
